For the Wil-son fam-ily, every lit-tle girl gets to be a princess for a day. But it comes at hor-ri-fy-ing cost. The patri-arch of the fam-ily, Randy Wil-son, founded the Amer-i-can cus-tom of purity balls: cer-e-monies where daugh-ters dress up in gowns and promise their fathers that they will remain vir-gins until mar-riage. The film focuses on Randy and his old-est unmar-ried daugh-ter Jor-dan (22 years old).

The film is pre-dictably dis-turb-ing, not because the fam-ily has hid-den secrets or are hyp-o-crit-i-cal monsters, but because they really do embody their own twisted Chris-t-ian ideals. The mood in the Wil-son home is suf-fo-cat-ing. Von Arx described the feel-ing of film-ing the Wilsons as "claus-tro-pho-bic" and it is comes across in the movie. Their entire exis-tence is wrapped up in gen-der norms that are so restric-tive being a woman is a full time job for the Wil-son ladies. Jor-dan waits to meet her hus-band while she teaches other young ladies to embody grace and man-ners at work-shops she orga-nizes. And every god-damn (sorry, I mean gosh darn) thing the fam-ily does is marked by some strange cer-e-mony they invented for the occa-sion, always pre-ceded by exhaust-ing beauty prep.

Von Arx some-times seems to reach a lit-tle when stat-ing the polit-i-cal impor-tance of the Wilsons, but their story is no doubt impor-tant when you con-sider how many peo-ple in Amer-ica are either just like the Wilsons or aspire to be. Per-haps most shock-ing of all is how sym-pa-thet-i-cally the fam-ily is rep-re-sented in the

movie. They are con-stantly reaf-firm-ing how much they love each other and they are prin-ci-pled, even if their prin-ci-ples are grotesque to most liberal-minded audi-ences. The audi-ence was obvi-ously at once hor-ri-fied and drawn in by the Wilsons. Despite a pointed and often mock-ing Q&A dis-cus-sion of the doc-u-men-tary, when Von Arx announced that after the film wrapped Jor-dan did indeed marry the man of her dreams, the crowd cheered.
