Women Make Movies Seeds the Field

In 2019, Dee Rees (on left in photo) , director of *MUDBOUND*, was the first African American woman to be nominated for Best Adapted Screenplay at the Academy Awards and Rachel Morrison, who she hired as Cinematographer, was the first women ever nominated in that category. Dee's first film, *PARIAH*, was supported by the WMM Production Assistance Program, as was *STRONG ISLAND*, which earned Yance Ford the first nomination for a transgender person in any category at the Academy Awards.



At Women Make Movies, **we believe the future of cinema is global, diverse filmmaking by and about women**, exploring the most critical, important stories impacting our world today by centering the voices and perspectives of women at the front lines.
